The Private Eye — Inquiry across the Curriculum

(One and Two-Day)

As part of The Private Eye Workshop, participants receive all the materials they need for the day's activities and leave ready to implement The Private Eye in their classrooms.

This workshop is a lively introduction to the hands-on, interdisciplinary Private Eye program. Participants explore The Private Eye strategy as they write, draw and theorize—using table-top fieldwork and outdoor fieldwork. The day alternates between team and individual work, as inquiry links to content. In an afternoon theorizing lab activity—all parts of The Private Eye process come together: looking closely, thinking by analogy, changing scale and theorizing. Each table is a mini-lab, as beautifully presented as a small museum and the room is surrounded with displays of student work, K-12. (Call for pricing which depends on number of workshops bundled, location, travel, etc.)
